Maquoit Yard Cemetery

Maquoit Yard Cemetery, also known as Maquoit Cemetery or the Baptist Burial Ground, is located on Maquoit Road, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is on the north side of the road and is partially enclosed by a chain link fence. Across the west end of the cemetery is stacked stone wall while along part of the north side of the cemetery is a very rough stone wall. The cemetery is composed of 396 marker stones and monuments with the earliest dated 1798. A sign mounted on the fence facing the road reads:

Maquoit Cemetery Site of Baptist Meeting House

First Church Constituted 1799.

A granite stone at the base of the flagpole reads:

Dedicated to our veterans by the grateful citizens of Brunswick

Contents

- 1) Map illustrating the general arrangement of the cemetery and showing the order of the detail maps.
- 2) Detail maps indicating the general placement of the individual marker stones and monuments.
- 3) Record of each individual stones inscription.
- 4) Index by family name giving the location in the cemetery.

Numbering of the markers is only as an aid in locating the stone within the context of this survey and do not represent any town or cemetery association designation.


Type of marker, be it Slate, Marble or Granite is indicated on the map for the cemetery.

Items enclosed by parenthesis in the marker stone record indicates information obtained from other sources as it is no longer readable on the stone.




MAQUOIT YARD CEMETERY - General Arrangement










MARSH CEMETERY - General Arrangement




MARSH CEMETERY - Range Layout

St. Paul's Memorial Garden

St. Paul's Memorial Garden is located on Pleasant Street, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is behind St. Paul's Episcopal Church and is enclosed by a metal fence. It is composed of a circular walkway having curved granite curbing along both sides of it on which the names and dates of those memorialized here are inscribed on the top surface, only the inner ring is inscribed at this time. Inside of the walkway are three tall, rough, granite stones set upright and outside are four granite blocks with serve as benches. St. Paul's Episcopal Church was founded in 1844 and the Memorial Garden was established in 1994, 150 years after the church was founded.







SIMPSON CEMETERY - General Arrangement




SIMPSON CEMETERY - Range Layout
