Varney Cemetery

Varney Cemetery is located on Pine Street in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. It is situated on the north side of the road and is completely fenced. The cemetery consists of 1,560 stones, the earliest dated 1832, and is still active.

A flagpole is located in the eastern section of the cemetery. The base of the flagpole is a large granite block which has marked on its south face:

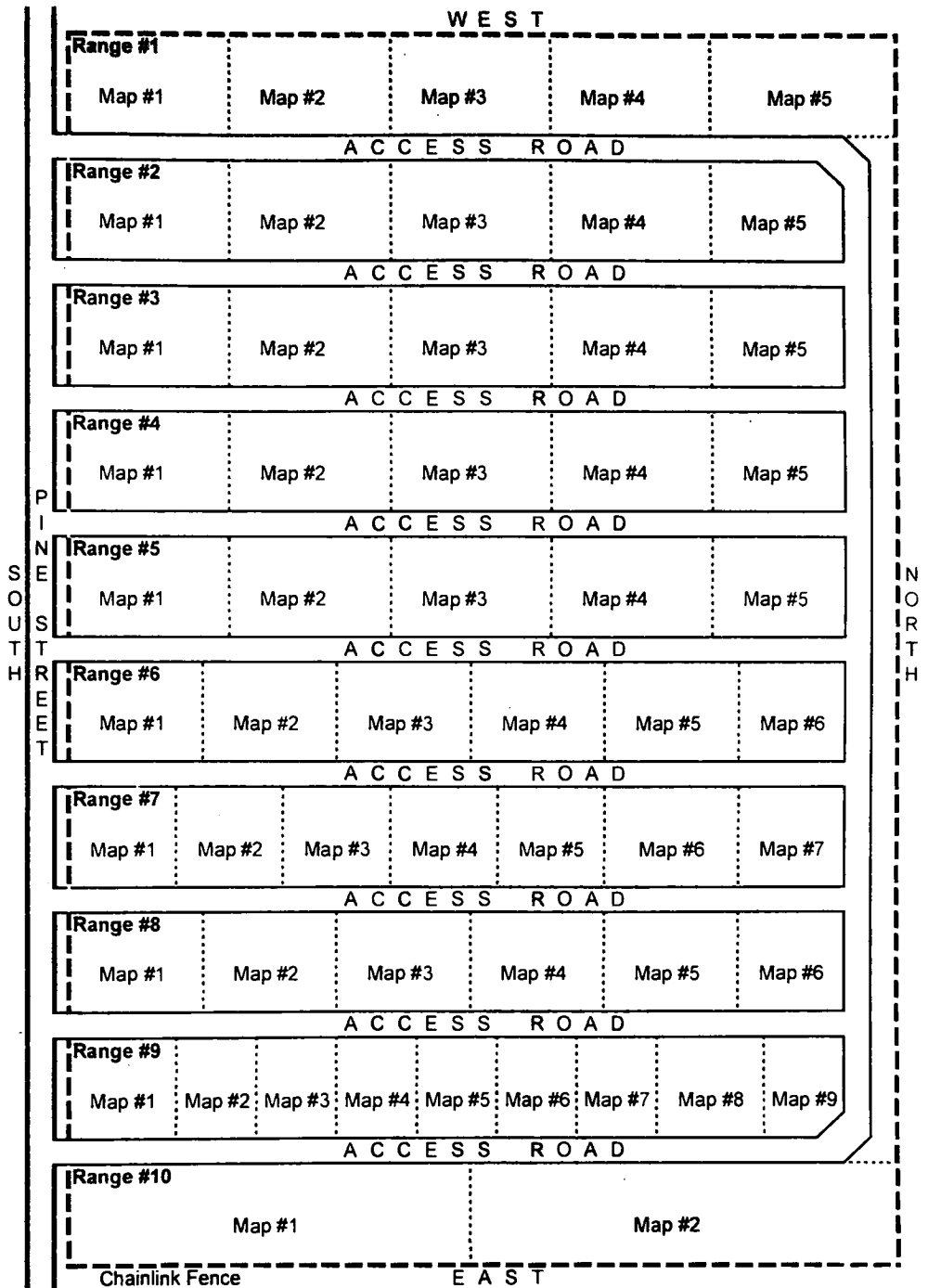
Numbering of the markers is only as an aid in locating the stone within the context of this survey and do not represent any town or cemetery association designation.

Detail maps indicate monuments and marker stones by a dark outline and footstones by a light outline. A double line indicates the side on which the marker stone or monument is inscribed. No double line indicates that the inscription is on the top surface of the stone.

Type of marker, be it Marble, Granite, Metal or Concrete is indicated on the detail maps for the cemetery. M = Marble. G = Granite, Mtl. = Metal and Conc. = Concrete.

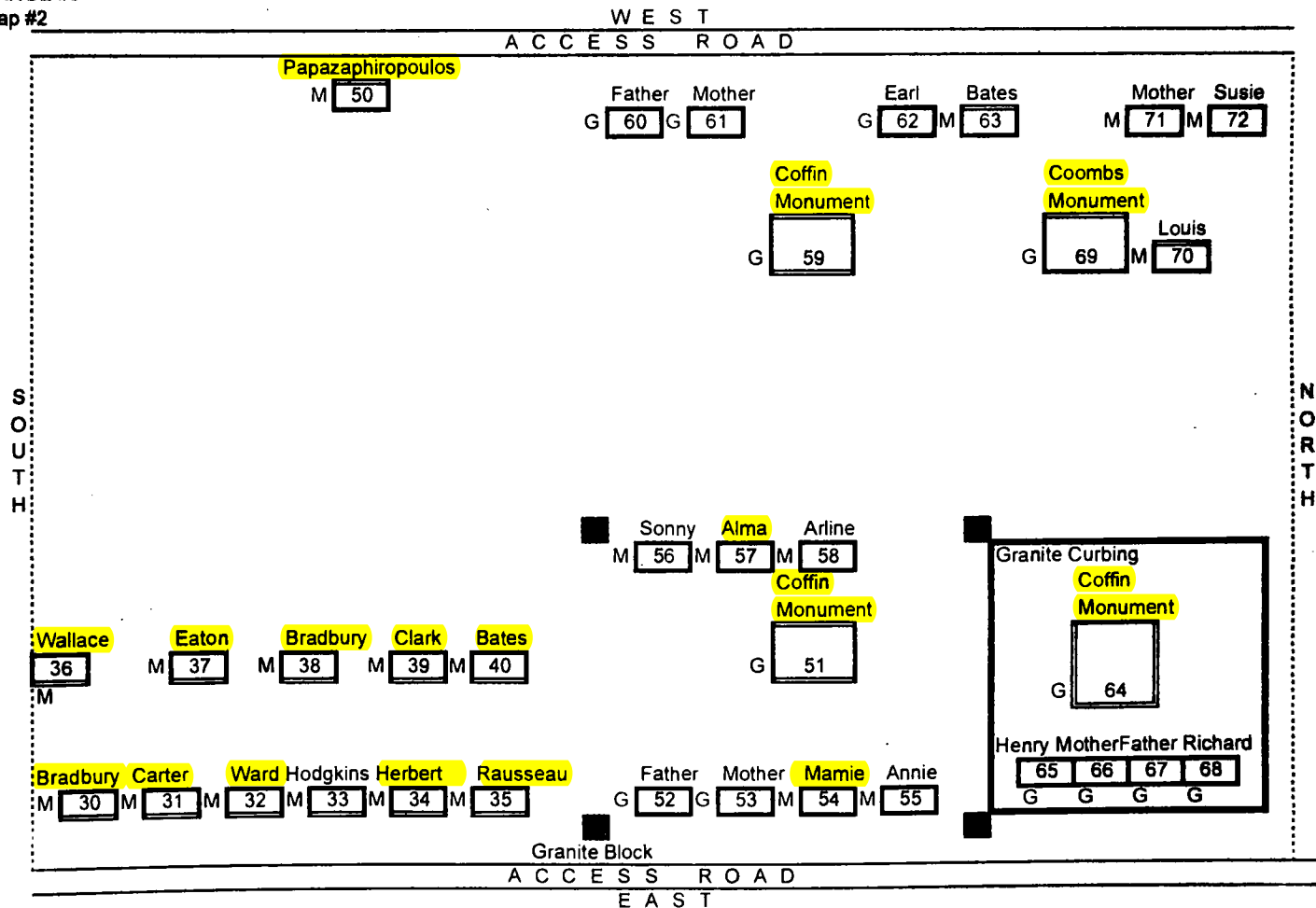

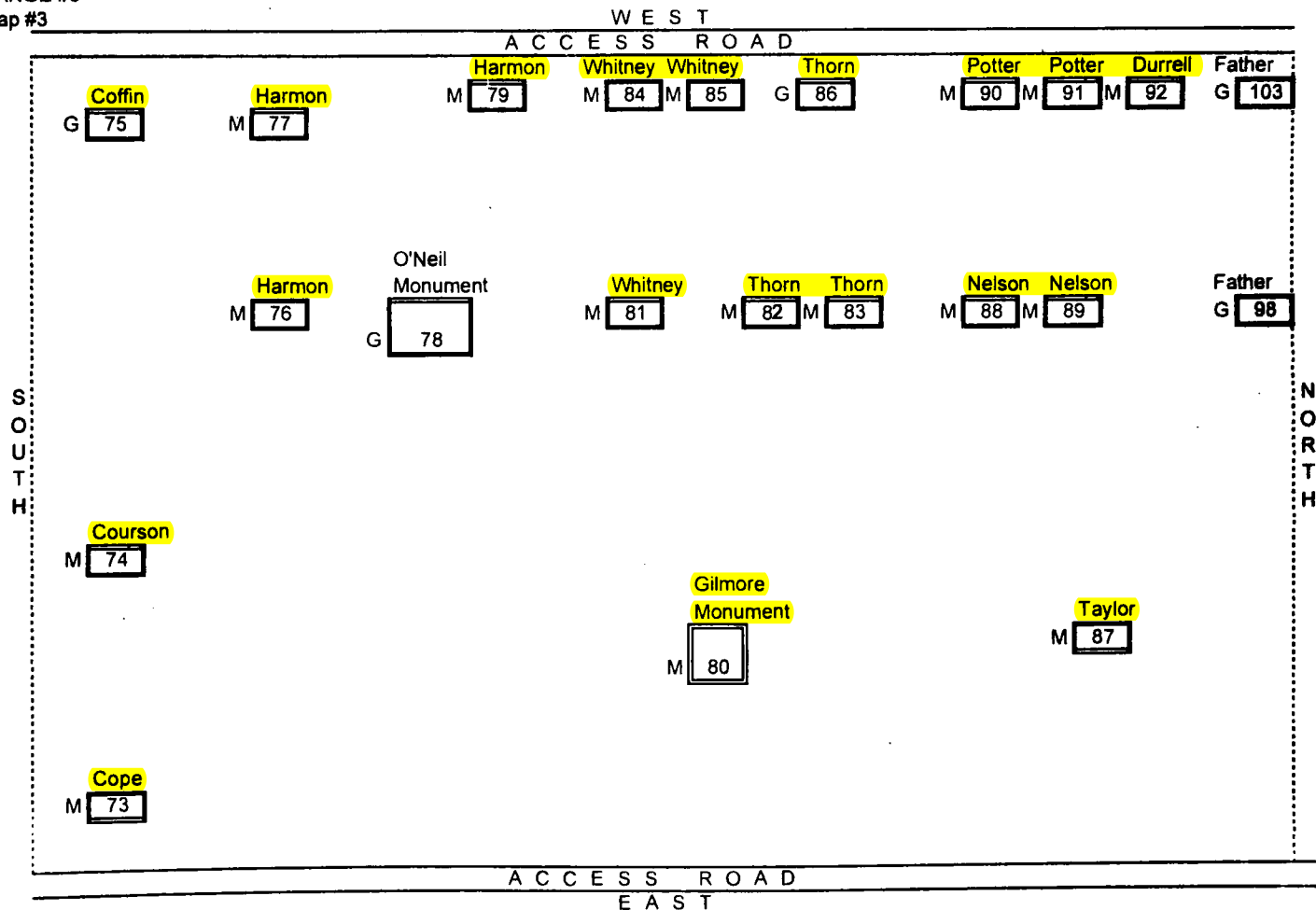

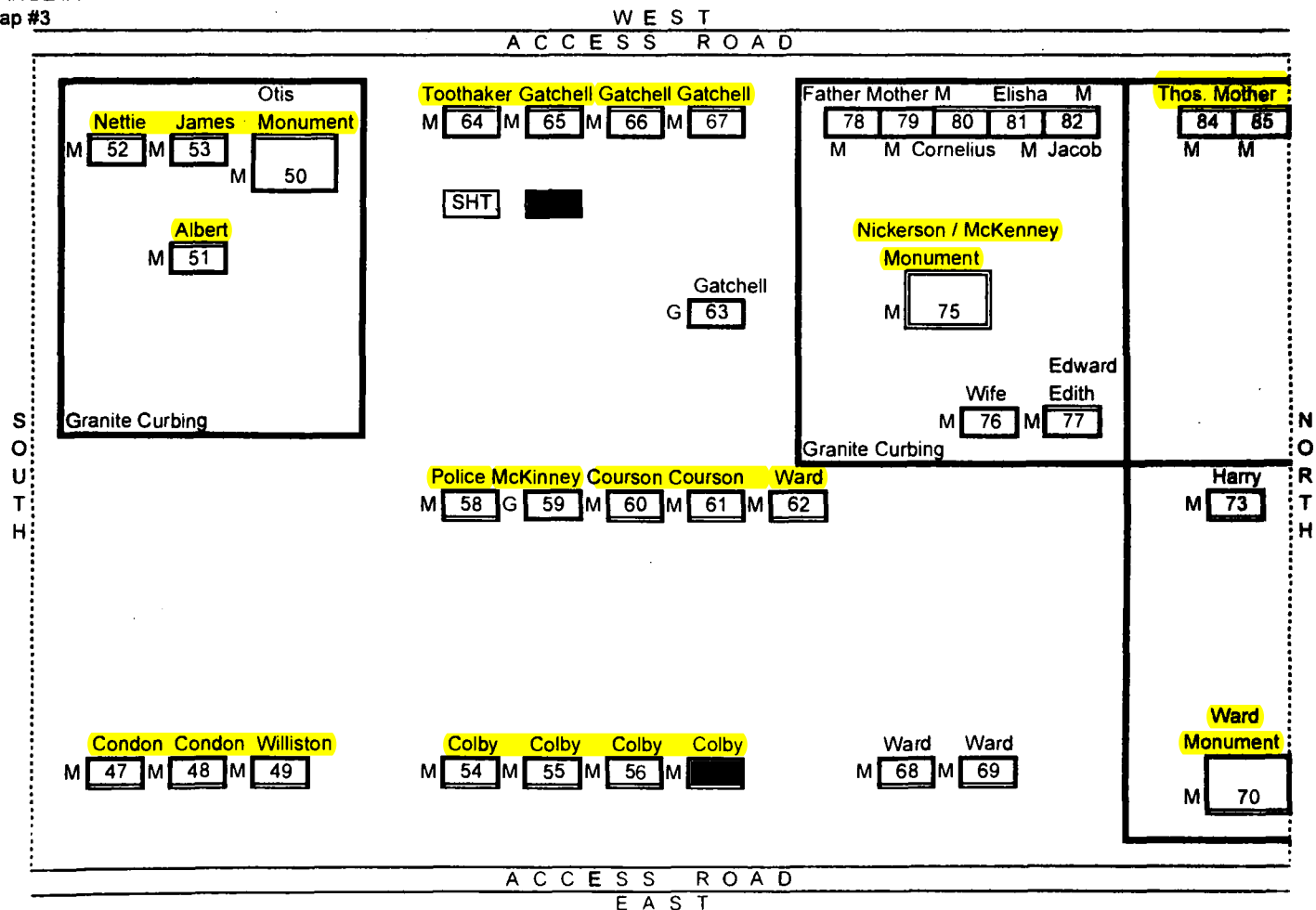

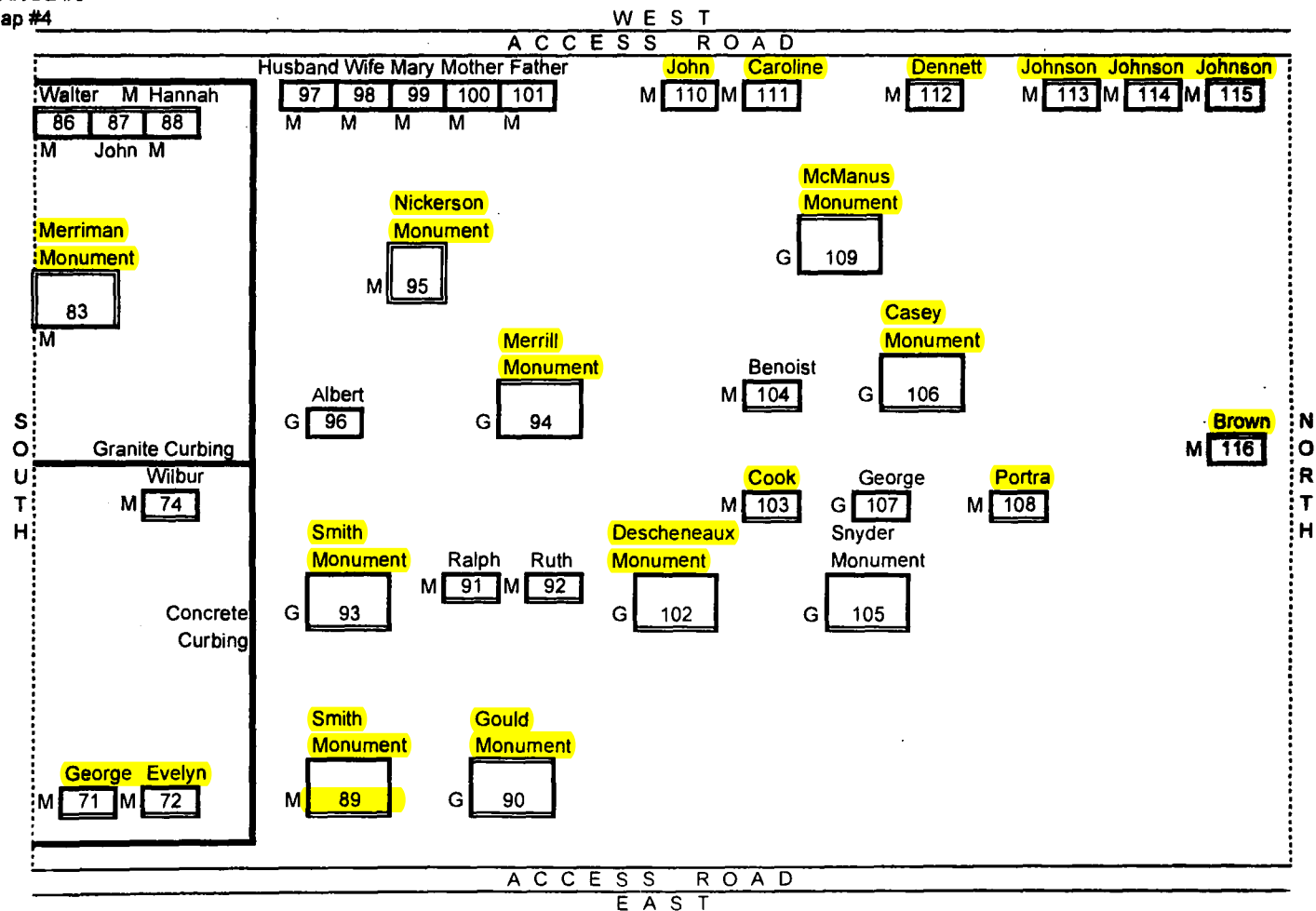
