Adams Cemetery

Adams Cemetery, also known as the Melcher or Hinkley Cemetery, is located on Adams Road, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is on the west side of Adams Road, adjacent to the road with a few large granite blocks bordering the roadside. It is composed of 15 marker stones with the earliest dated 1792. In back of the cemetery a steep banking leads down to a marsh.

Ancient Burial Ground

The Ancient Burial Ground was located off Maine Street, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery it is thought was in the area now occupied by the underpass which leads to Mill Street west of Maine Street. Nothing remains of this cemetery, but a plaque commemorating it is located on a boulder near the main entrance of Fort Andross, formerly the Cabot Mill. The commemorative plaque was placed here by the 'Daughters of the American Revolution' local chapter in 1930. It reads:

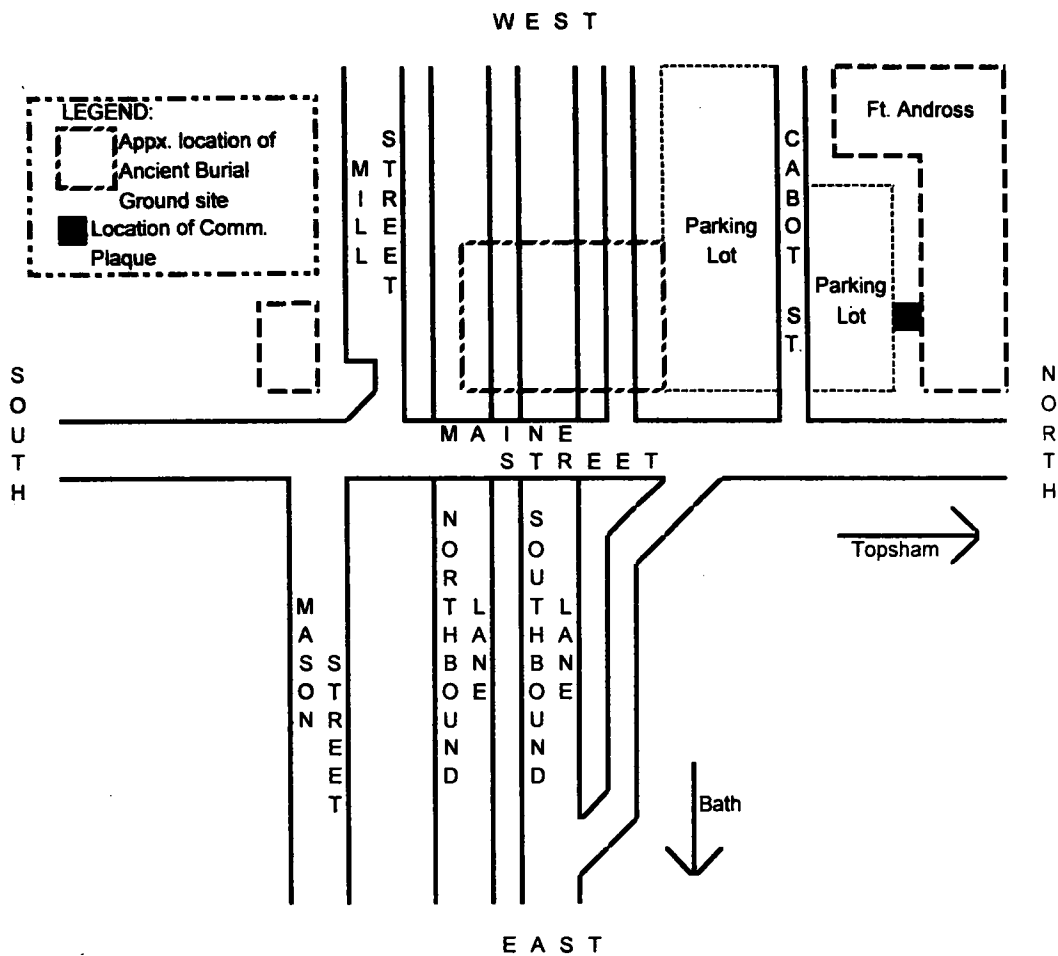

Chase Cemetery

Chase Cemetery, also known as Bunganuc, Campbell or Jameson Cemetery, is located on the Flying Point Road, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is on private property on the south side of the Flying Point Road, set back in off the edge of a posted field about one mile west from Bunganuc Stream near the Freeport Town Line. The cemetery is composed of 11 stones with the earliest dated 1786 and is enclosed in a very rough stone wall at this time. When first visited in 1968 the cemetery was in far better condition, as it has deteriorated badly in the last 36 years. The map and records of the inscriptions from that date are here utilized with the 2 stones added since that time included; as most of the original stones are now broken and unreadable.

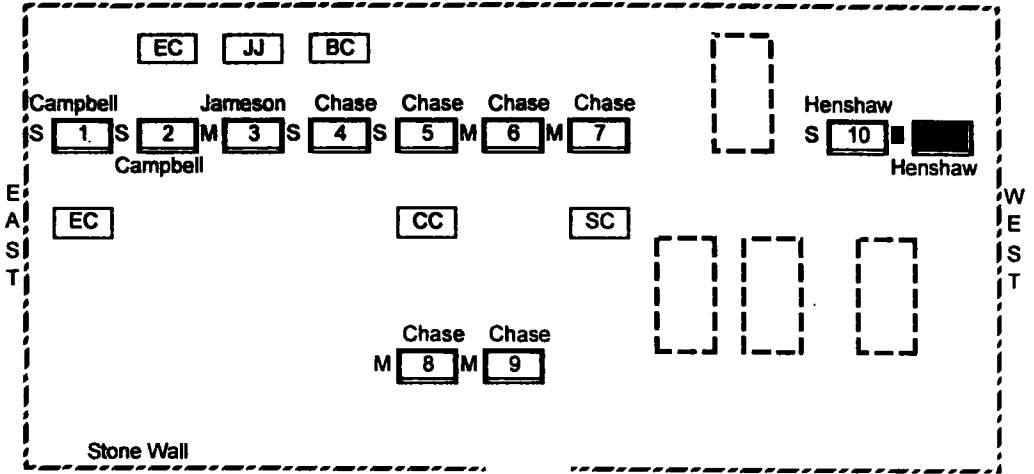

First Parish Cemetery & Memorial Garden

First Parish Cemetery, also known as the Mere Point Cemetery, is located on Maine Street in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is on Upper Maine Street near the intersection of Pleasant Hill Road and is composed of 180 marker stones and monuments with the earliest dated 1735. The Cemetery was originally the site of the first Meeting House of the First Parish Church established in 1717. The Meeting House was begun in 1719 but not completed until 1735, at which time the cemetery was founded. The Meeting House was lost to fire in 1834. The First Parish Memorial Garden was established in the back end of the cemetery in 2000 in which are placed the ashes of those more recently interred here and memorialized upon a large polished granite monument.

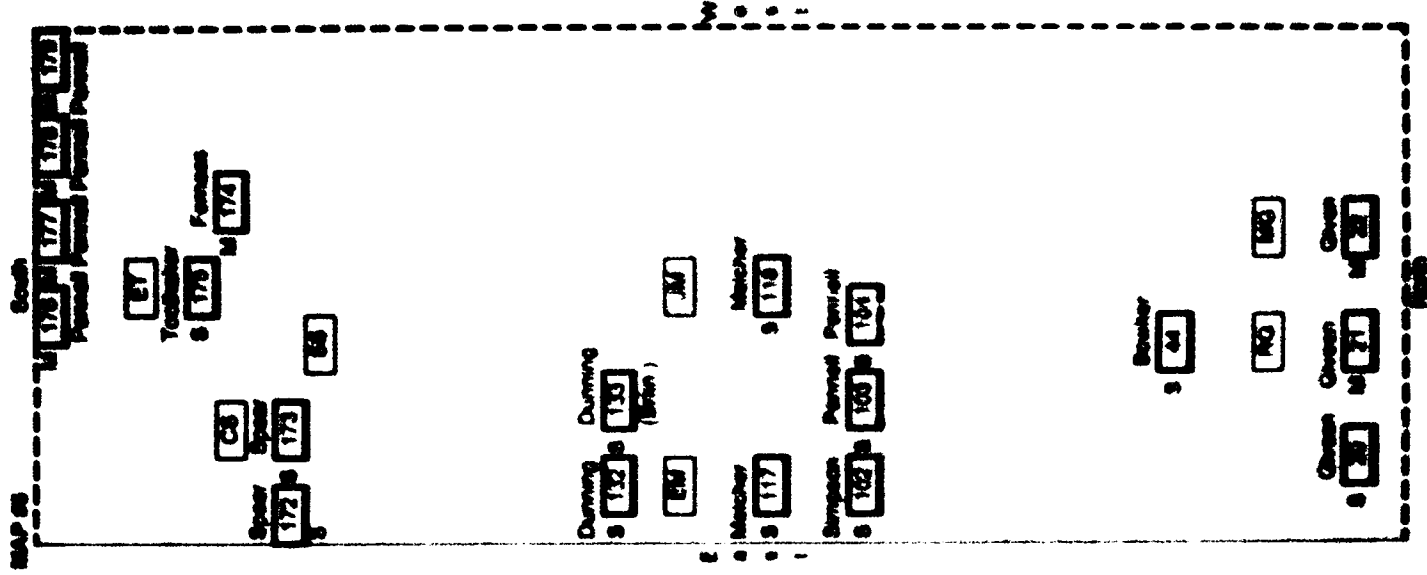

HARTWELL / LITTLE - General Arrangement



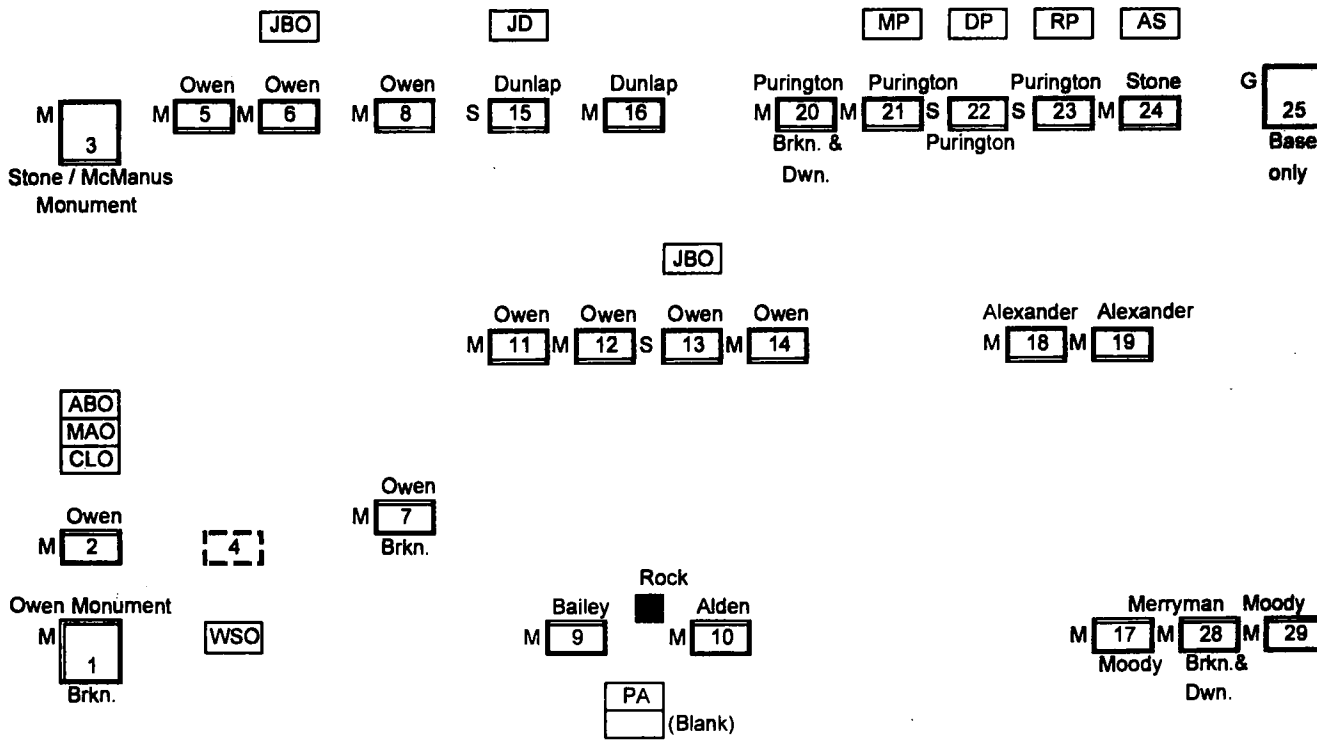

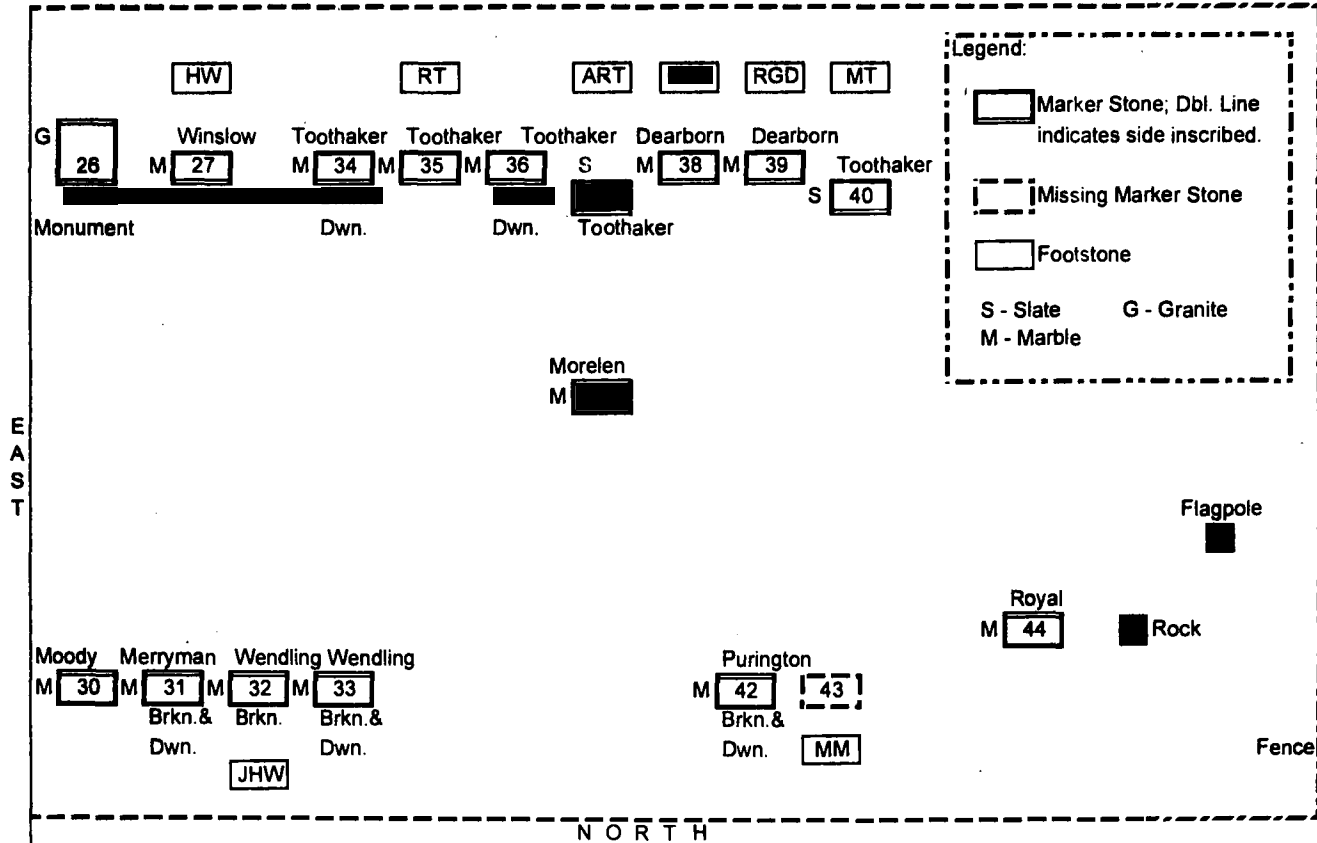

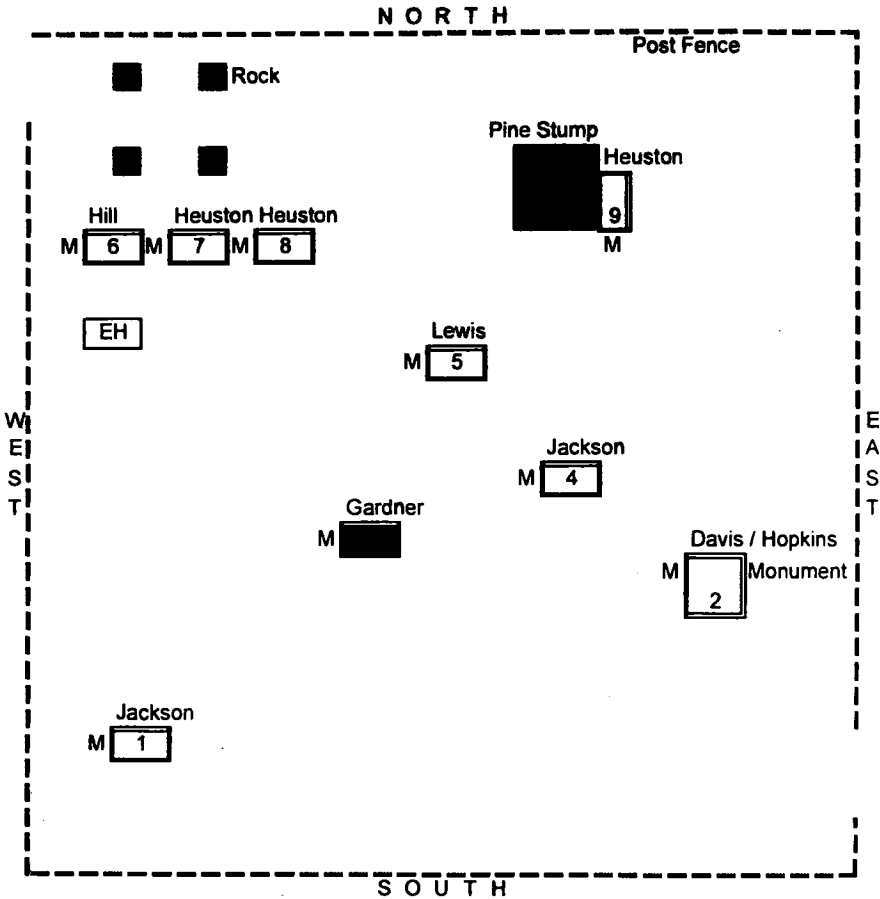
