Harding Cemetery

Harding Cemetery, also known as Thompson Brook Cemetery is located on the Old Bath Road in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. It is situated on the south side of the road on a rise and is partially fenced. The cemetery consists of 290 stones, the earliest dated 1830, and is still active. A flagpole located near the center of the cemetery has at its base a granite slab marked:

DEDICATED TO OUR VETERANS BY THE GRATEFUL CITIZENS OF BRUNSWICK

Contents

1) Map illustrating the general arrangement of the cemetery and indicating the numbering of the detail maps.

2) Detail maps indicating the placement of the individual stones and markers.

3) Record of each individual stones inscription.

4) Index by family name giving the location in the cemetery corresponding to the maps and text.

Note

Numbering of the markers is only as an aid in locating the stone within the context of this survey and do not represent any town or cemetery association designation.

Detail maps indicate monuments and marker stones by a dark outline and footstones by a light outline. A double line indicates the side on which the marker stone or monument is inscribed. No double line indicates that the inscription is on the top surface of the stone.

Type of marker, be it Slate, Marble, Granite or Metal is indicated on the detail maps for the cemetery. S = Slate, M = Marble, G = Granite and Mtl. = Metal.

This record of Harding Cemetery was produced by Donald Cheetham of Brunswick. Maine and Mark Cheetham of Richmond, Maine in 2006.




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


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



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
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




New Meadows Cemetery

New Meadows Cemetery is located at the present end of the Purinton Road in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. It is situated on the east side of the road and is entirely fenced as is the road leading to it. The cemetery consists of 624 stones, the earliest dated 1792, and is still active. A flagpole located near the center of the cemetery has at its base a granite plaque which is marked:

> Dedicated to our veterans by grateful citizens of Brunswick.







Pennell Cemetery is located in the woods between the Simpson Point Road and Old Pennell Way in the section of Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine known as Pennellville or Middle Bay. The semetery is on private property on a slight rise amongst large White Pines with no access and is not fenced or otherwise marked. The cemetery consists of but 6 stones which are still readable, the earliest lated 1840, and has not been used for many years. It is said that some of the people buried here are written of in the books "Captain Abby and Captain John" by Robert P. Tristram Coffin.


