Jones Cemetery

Jones Cemetery, also known as the Friends, Lisbon Falls Road or Quaker Cemetery, is located on Lisbon Falls Road, in Brunswick, Cumberland County, Maine. The cemetery is on the east side of Lisbon Falls Road, surrounded by woods on the other 3 sides and having a fence on the west and south sides of the cemetery and about half way along the north side. It is composed of 65 marker stones and monuments with the earliest dated 1828.

Contents

- 1) Map illustrating the general arrangement of the cemetery and showing the order of the detail maps.
- 2) Detail maps indicating the general placement of the individual marker stones and monuments.
- 3) Record of each individual stones inscription.
- 4) Index by family name giving the location in the cemetery.

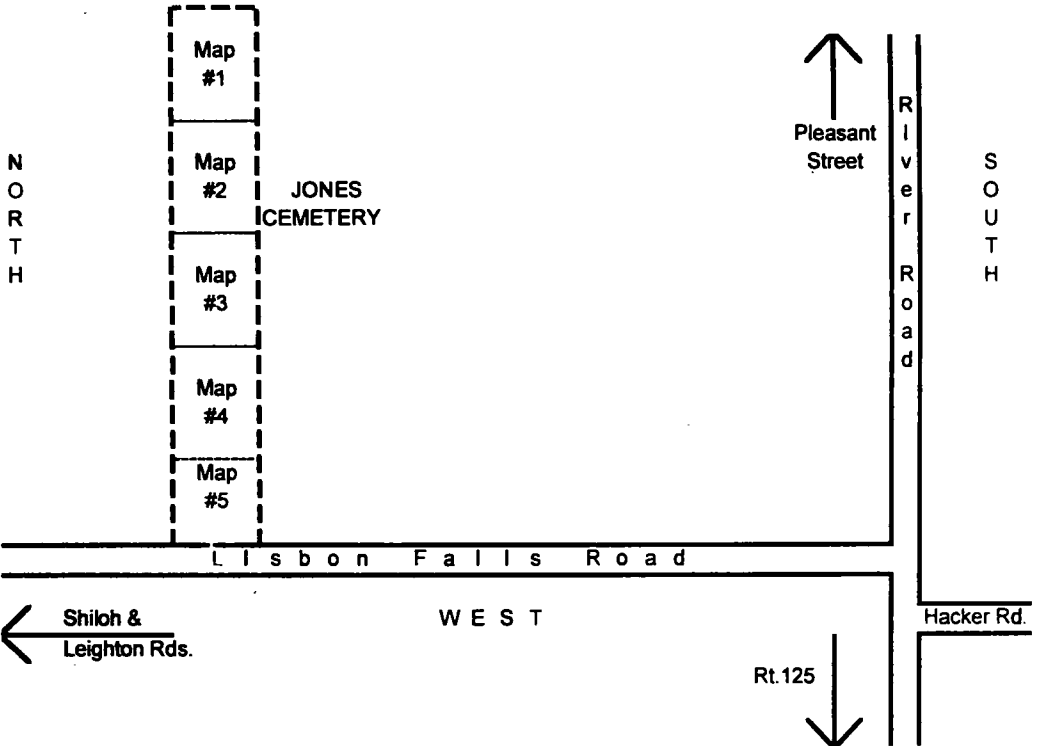
Numbering of the markers is only as an aid in locating the stone within the context of this survey and do not represent any town or cemetery association designation.

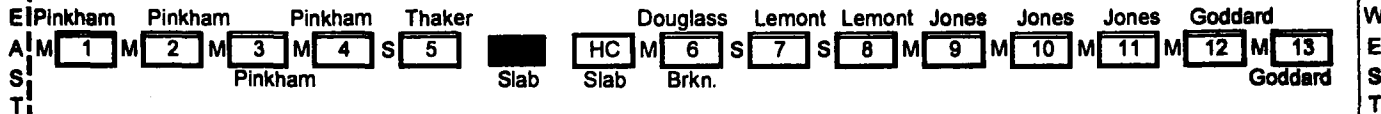
